- I. Opening Prayer – Sosen Kyrie at 7:00 PM
- II. Report of the Executive Board
 - a. President – George Athanasiou
 - i. Reported that the weekend was very busy.
 - ii. Board of Trustees meeting – Athanasiou would be making presentation
 - iii. Next Wednesday there would be a meeting with the alumni
 - iv. Discussed the possibility of moving the SGA meeting to 7:30 PM in order to accommodate certain individuals schedules.
 1. Was voted upon, with the agreement that meetings would continued to always end by 9:00 PM
 2. Pavlakos moved; Kakis seconded the motion. Vote approved to move meeting time to 7:30 PM

- III. Report of the Dean of Students –
 - a. Parking
