

Overview of Documentation

Students with Disabilities

If you have received accommodations for a learning, physical or psychological disability in the past, or if you are requesting accommodations for the first time, you must submit documents to the Office of Academic Services.

Please note that IEPs and 504 plans from high school/elementary school are not sufficient for receiving accommodations. There must be the initial, or ongoing, diagnosis of the learning disability, not just the follow-up reports.

The following documents outline the guidelines for documentation:

- 1. Medical Disability (Physical and Psychological) Documentation Guidelines

 - b. HIPPA release form to be sent to the provider
 - c. Checklist for provider
- 2. Learning Disabilities Documentation Guidelines

 - d. FERPA form to be sent to school

When accommodations are determined, you will receive a letter of accommodations, which will then be sent to each of your instructors in order to receive the necessary accommodations.
